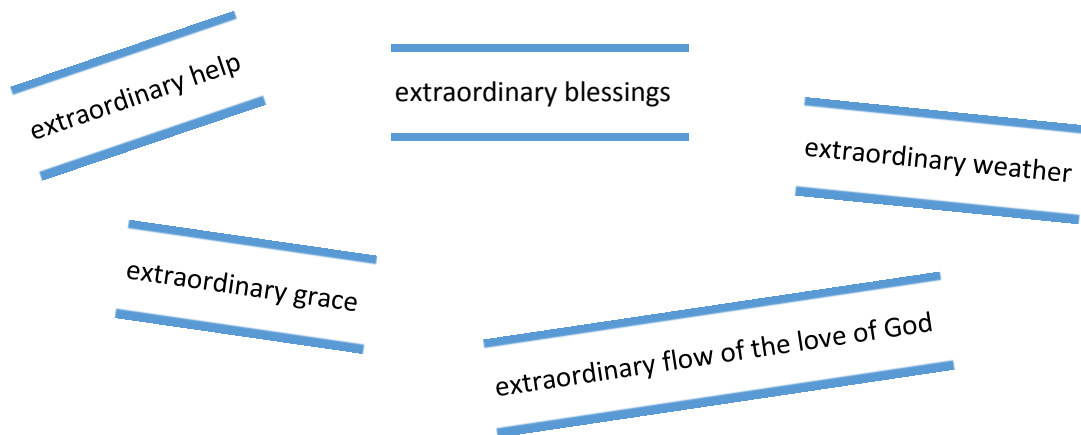
Purpose of the Barnabas Project:

Distributions mean discovering treasures, and often, hidden treasures.



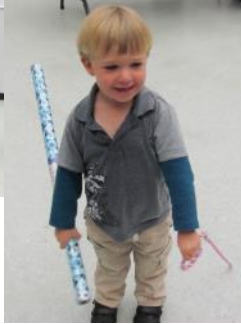
Flowers were big among the smallest.
